

# Submission Guidelines

**Authors should submit their manuscripts online via "Submit a Manuscript" link on the homepage of the journal.** Manuscripts are accepted only in **Word format**. First-time users must create an account first.

Authors should submit manuscripts together with these documents, including manuscript body, title page, a turnitin similarity rate report, and a turnitin AI writing rate report.

Originality: Content must be original, unpublished, and not under consideration elsewhere

Plagiarism: Must be below 10%

AI-Generated Content: Must be 0% (no AI-generated content is allowed).

Language: Must be written in high

## Manuscript Preparation

- Papers should be in English. Either British or American the spelling should be consistent throughout.
- Papers submitted to the conference for publication should not be under review with another journal or conference.
- Article length should not be exceed 6 pages and in standard two columns IEEE format.
- Authors should prepare their manuscripts in a way that does not give away their identity. Submit the Title Page containing the Authors details and Blinded Manuscript with no author details as two separate files.

## Text

- Page setting: A4 format with (minimum) 2 cm margins on all four sides
- Always use one font and size, preferably: Times New Roman, 12 pt.
- Use line spacing 1,5 throughout
- Justify your text both on the left and right
- Words you like to have in italic or bold have to be written this way in the text
- Your manuscript must be numbered consecutively from the first to the last pages

## Citations

- Complete sentences have to be placed within "double quotation marks"
- Partial quotations have to be placed within 'single quotation marks'.
- Partial quotations keep their place within the running text corpus
- Additions and clarifications are placed within square brackets [...]

## Paragraphs

- Use one hard return in the body of the text only to end a paragraph. In all other cases, let the text automatically wrap around
- Indicate new paragraphs with a tab, not with an extra blank line

## Reference Styles

Our preferred style for referencing is based on the IEEE or APA Format (6th ed.). Please ensure that it is consistent throughout the notes, references and bibliography.

## Figures, Tables, and Illustrations

- The maximum width of the table on the page is 12 cm
- Put all tables in a separate MS Word file and upload it to the submission system
- You may prefer to put each tables in separate MS Word files and upload them to the submission system.
- All figures/tables must be numbered and captioned.
- Submit high-resolution figures (minimum 300+ dpi). Acceptable formats: JPEG, PNG, TIFF, or EPS.
- Ensure that all figures are your original work, or that you have secured written permission for third-party images.
